

Mississippi Personal Income Tax Extensions

Mississippi Tax Extension Form:

- To request a Mississippi extension, file Form 80-106 by the original due date of your return and pay any income tax due.
- If you have an approved Federal tax extension ([IRS Form 4868](#)), you will automatically receive a Mississippi tax extension. In this case, you do not need to file Form 80-106 unless you're making a state tax payment. This means if there is a tax due payment for the Mississippi state then along with check below form needs to be mailed to the address mentioned in the form else the extension to file tax return will not be granted along with Federal.
